St. Patrick's R.E. program: Confirmation: We are gearing back up to preparing our youth for confirmation. We have Sunday, October 17, 2021 confirmed as the date when Bishop William Joensen will be coming to St. Patrick's Irish Settlement to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation.

As part of the sacramental preparation, we have made the decision to meet in the main body of St. Patrick's Irish Settlement Church to view the videos that are part of our *Chosen Your Journey Toward Confirmation* program.
