From the desk of Father Dooley: Some may remember a couple of weeks ago I was away on my annual retreat. It is a time of prayer and reflection meant to "recharge" my batteries. Some 20 priest from all over the Midwest prayed together and listen to the retreat master give 3 conferences a day. The focus of course was on priesthood and the desire to be a good shepherd. This year each meditation was rooted in the life of Christ from the Annunciation to Pentecost. The retreat master who gave the meditations was ordained in 2016, my I felt old. In reflecting on the life of Christ we went from giving our "fiat" each day as Mary did at the Annunciation to developing a deeper relationship with the Holy Spirit as at Pentecost. We were encouraged to make a few good resolutions to work on in our priestly spiritual life.

Retreats and days of prayer are much needed not only by the priest but by the lay faithful as well. The season of Lent which begins on March 2nd can become a time of great prayer and reflection for those setting in the pews. In order for us to have a strong spiritual life we need to have quiet time to hear the whisper of God's voice calling us to conversion. It is my hope that each parishioner will take advantage of all the opportunities that the parish provides: Bible Studies, Holy Hours, Formed, Stations of the Cross and the Sacraments of Reconciliation and Eucharist. Start planning now for a strong and holy Lent, you will not be disappointed.

Reflection Questions: Am I happy with my spiritual life? Could I make one or two resolutions for my spiritual life? When did I last go on a retreat? How do I experience God's grace in my life?
