From the desk of Father Dooley: The Church recognizes that there are many calls to love which the Lord invites men and women to consider. But there is a call to love which is done for the service of the Church as priest, deacon, or as consecrated religious, those whom we call brothers or sisters. The focus of their lives is to follow our Lord and give their lives completely to the service of God's people.

Bishops, Priests and Deacons share in the Sacrament of Holy Orders. A bishop receives the fullness of the sacrament which confers a sacred power for teaching, preaching, sanctifying, and governing the people of God. He is the visible head of a particular Church we call a diocese. A bishop is the successor of the Apostles and under the authority of our Holy Father Pope Francis. Priests are co-workers with the bishop in a diocese and act in the person of Christ the head. They minister in a local Church called a parish. There the priest offers the sacrificial gifts of the people to God and then offers to the people the body of Christ in the Eucharist. By the laying on of hands and anointing with Chrism those called to priesthood are given an indelible mark, forever changing their relationship to Christ and to the Church. In the Latin Church men aspiring to priesthood must embrace celibacy freely for the love of God's kingdom and the service of others. Deacons are ordained for the work of service in the Church by ministry of the Word and works of Charity. Some married men are ordained as Permanent Deacons like Deacon Sam Sullivan. Currently Eric Pugh is completing his formation to be ordained a permanent deacon. They will preach the Word, assist at the altar, and accomplish works of charity in the community.

Those called to live as consecrated religious, Brothers and Sister normally take vows of poverty, chastity and obedience. They teach the youth, take care of the elderly, or run homeless programs. Whatever need is greatest.
