From the Pastor's Desk: There are many memorials of Saints during the month of July. St Thomas the Apostle (July 3) took the gospel of Christ to the people of southern India. St Elizabeth of Portugal (July 4) who was Queen of Portugal and after her husband died, she gave away her wealth to the poor. She died in 1336. St. Maria Goretti (July 6) gave her life for Christ at the age of twelve in 1902. She is the patron for young girls that they may live purity of life. St Benedict (July 11) is the founder of western monasticism, the Benedictines. He died in 547. St Henry (July 13) was elected Holy Roman Emperor who worked for the reform of Church. He died in 1024. Saint Kateri Tekakwitha (July 14) was a Mohawk Native America who endured hardships to be a Christian. She was devoted to the Eucharist and Christ Crucified. She died in 1680. St Bonaventure (July 15) was a learned bishop and is known for his writings on philosophy and theology. He died in 1274. Our Lady of Mt Carmel (July 16) is a feast day for the Carmelites who were founded on Mt Carmel in Israel. St Mary Magdalene (July 22) was a disciple of the Lord who came to the tomb that first Easter Sunday. St. Bridget of Sweden (July 23) was a mother of eight. As a widow she founded a religious order, the Brigantines. She died in 1373. St. James the Apostle (July 25) is the disciple who led the early Church in Jerusalem. He was martyred in the year 42. Sts. Joachim & Ann (July 26) are the parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the mother of Jesus. St. Martha (July 29) is the sister of Mary and Lazarus. She welcome Jesus into her home. St. Peter Chrysologus (July 30) was bishop of Ravenna Italy. He died in 450. Ignatius of Loyola (July 31) is the founder of the Society of Jesus, the Jesuits. He is known for his spiritual exercises. He died in 1556.

All the saints are role models for us on our pilgrimage to the Kingdom of God. They also pray for us and our intentions before the throne of God. We should see them as members of the household of our Father.
